Curriculum Connections

- Conceptual Understandings
 - Our actions can make a difference in the world
 - We are learning that our actions and choices can affect nature and the environment
- Overall Expectation Addressed

Pre-Activity

- Brainstorm Time (*As a class, brainstorm your ideas on chart paper, white board, etc.*)
 - What are some animals that might live in a marsh?
 - What are some ways that we can help animals in our own backyards and parks?

Post-Video

- Refer to the brainstorm lists from before the video
 - Now that we have watched the video, were there any other animals we need to add to our list?
 - *Animals seen in video: Mute Swans, Snapping Turtle, Red-winged Blackbird, Great Egret. Otter. Bullfrog*
 - In the video we learned about 3 ways that we can help animals. Do we have them on our list?
- Worksheet
 - Students can use the worksheet to draw a picture of some of the animals that live in a marsh.
